Itinerary

- 1010hrs - Meet and greet at hotel lobby by Kimraya representative. Transfer from hotel to Jesselton Point Jetty for a 20 minute boat trip to Gayana Island Eco Resort. Boat depart at 1030hrs.
- 1100hrs - On arrival, meet by staff of the resort and proceed to the Marine Ecology Research Center (**MERC**) where researchers are working in propagating Giant Clams and restoring coral reefs.
- Watch a Video Show at the resort audio visual centre.
 - After the video show, proceed to the exhibition area of the **MERC**.
 - Briefing by the resident researcher.
 - Touch and feel some of the friendly Marine creatures at the touch and feel tank.
 - **Under the resort MERC Giant clam propagation program, visitors can observe the researchers daily work to arrest the decline of the World's Giant Clam population.**
- 1200hrs - Lunch at Alu Alu Restaurant.
1300hrs - Depart Gayana Eco Resort for Jesselton Point Jetty
1330hrs - Arrive at Jetty and depart for hotel.
1340hrs - Arrive at Hotel. End of Tour
